Your Step-by-Step Guide for Starting Your Walk with Jesus

## Core Steps to Begin Your Journey

### - Read the Bible Daily

Start with the Gospel of John or the book of Romans. Read a little each day and think about what it means.

### - Talk to God in Prayer

Prayer is simply talking to God. Thank Him, ask for help, confess sin, and share your heart.

### - Get Baptized

Baptism is a public step of obedience that shows your new life in Jesus. Talk to a local church about getting baptized.

### - Find a Bible-Believing Church

Look for a local church that teaches God's Word and encourages your spiritual growth.

### - Connect with Other Believers

You're not meant to walk alone. Join a Bible study, small group, or Christian community.

### - Write Down Your Story

Record how you came to faith. It'll help you share your testimony and remember what God has done.

## First 7 Days with Jesus

- Day 1 - Read John 1 and pray for understanding.
- Day 2 - Write out your salvation story.
- Day 3 - Explore church options nearby.
- Day 4 - Memorize John 3:16.
- Day 5 - Watch a sermon or Bible study online.
- Day 6 - Pray for your family and friends to know Jesus.
- Day 7 - Reflect on your first week and journal what God is teaching you.

## 5 Key Bible Verses to Remember

- John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son...
- Romans 10:9 - If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord...
